

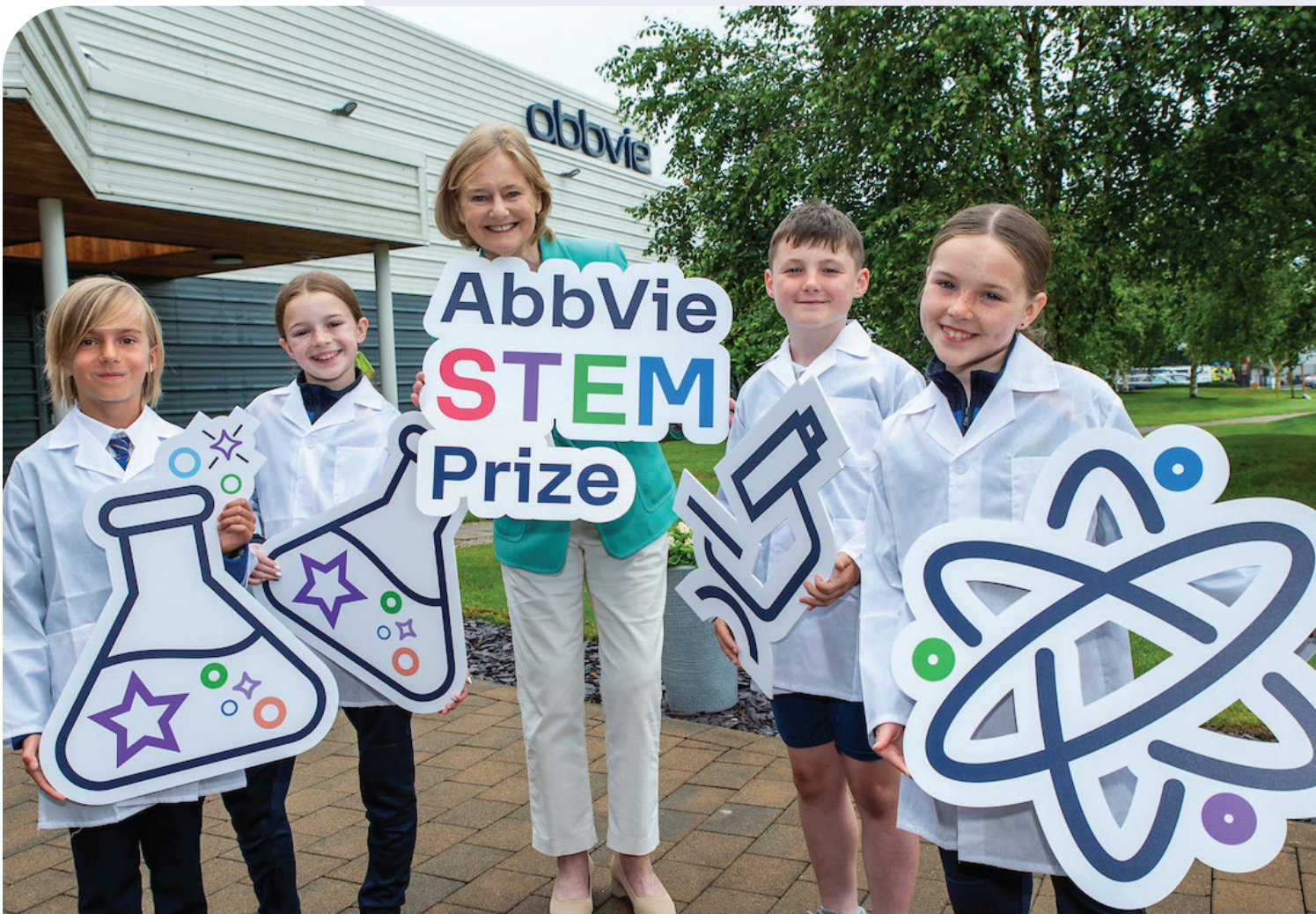
AbbVie STEM Prize

What is the AbbVie STEM Prize?

All you have to do is think of a project that would make a difference to your locality and link it to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs). It could be a project that helps the environment, an investigation that improves our health, or an awareness programme that educates your community, there's no limit to what you can do together.

In order to enter, your class needs to follow these steps:

1. Come up with a STEM project that links to the SDGs.
2. Work on that project and communicate your findings to others in the community e.g., Family, other classes, people in your local area.
3. Make a poster that highlights what you did.
4. Film a two-minute video going through the poster and answering some questions about it.
5. Submit your video entry.

Follow the guide as it will help you describe your work and explain what the judges are looking for.

- Raise awareness about the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Enhance participants' understanding of the UN Sustainable Development Goals and the pressing global issues they aim to tackle
- Provide a platform for children to become change-makers within their communities
- Provide an opportunity for children to become agents of change in their local communities.
- Inspire participants to identify and address specific challenges within their local communities using STEM-based solutions
- Encourage children to become catalysts for positive change by developing STEM projects that address local challenges.
- Make a positive impact in Ireland and close to home
- Address local challenges

Task for Participants: Identify a challenge or opportunity within your local community that could benefit from a STEM-based solution. This could range from environmental or climate concerns to issues such as sugar intake, fitness levels, how plants grow, or single use plastic in the school. The UN's Sustainable Development Goals were designed to help make the world a better place and they act as a guide to help us understand what areas we need to work on in order to do that. Often, these global concepts are big and difficult to understand. But, through the AbbVie STEM Prize, children and teachers can work together on a local project that will help everyone understand what sustainability is.
